

SAFETY CAGES

If your vehicle has a safety cage, it must comply with Schedule J of the CAMS Manual and you must complete all three (3) copies of the Safety Cage Registration Form and submit this (or a Safety Cage Certificate) with your application CAMS for processing.

PHOTOGRAPH REQUIREMENTS

Two sets of 10cm x 7cm prints of each of the following are required for the logbook:

¾ Front view



¾ Rear view



Note: Images not to scale

The vehicle photographs must be in colour, of professional quality, and of the appropriate size. Polaroids are not acceptable. The photographs must be in focus and preferably devoid of extraneous objects (such as workshop equipment) in the background. Photographs may be emailed to CAMS: logbooks@cams.com.au
